ENTRY INFORMATION: One entry form may be used for all days. An entry form is included in this premium list.

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC limited registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. **Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are eligible to participate, provided that their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Please designate the dog's breed as "All American Dog" on the entry form.**

Online entries are available for these trials through AKC's Online Entry service. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries per day designated as either online or paper will be **100 runs/trial online, 250 runs/trial paper**. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hours time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly. The club is not maintaining a wait list for online entries. Paper entries can be mailed to the Trial Secretary's address (above) or hand delivered, but no hand delivered entries can be accepted within the first 24 hours after opening. Express mail must be designated "no signature required." If using non-postal express delivery services, contact trial secretary for delivery address.

A full refund of entry fees will be given for any bitch that comes into season, provided that written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary at least one-half hour before the commencement of the trial. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the Trial grounds.**

EMLKC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries (runs) will be placed on the club's wait list for each day. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be **received** by the Trial Secretary prior to **Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at 6:00 PM**. Any entries **withdrawn**, with notification to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail OK) by **6:00 PM on Monday, March 2, 2020** will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry; otherwise no refund will be given for entries withdrawn **AFTER** closing, except as specified above for bitches in season. Any wait listed entry that does not get into the trial will receive a full refund. Any entries withdrawn **BEFORE** closing will receive a full refund.

We will have a white board available for volunteers to sign up. Please consider volunteering to work – even if you are only available to work for one height in a class, that will help the trials run more smoothly!

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for Qualifying scores and for first through fourth place in each height division in each class.

Regular Classes **First Place:** Blue **Second Place:** Red **Third Place:** Yellow **Fourth Place:** White
Qualifying Score: Dark Green

A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show.

A toy (value \$1-\$5) will be provided for each dog entered for the weekend, available at the ribbon table.

All dogs completing a MACH, PACH, or PAX at this trial will receive a MACH/PACH/PAX bar and ribbon. If you are close, please let the trial secretary know ahead of time so that we can be ready to celebrate with you!

LOCATION FOR TRIAL: Kenny Ardell Building, Grant County Fairgrounds, Moses Lake, WA

These agility trials will be held indoors on dirt, in 2 rings 100' x 100'. Crating will be available inside the arena, but space is limited, so please plan to use space efficiently. X-pens are OK if used to contain multiple dogs. **We ask that all dogs be securely contained without risk of getting loose; hard crates and x-pen covers not required but recommended for dogs at risk of getting out. We ask this for the safety of all dogs involved.** The building has modern restroom facilities. Snacks and lunch will be provided for workers. The club will accept monetary donations for food from those not working, after workers have had the opportunity to get lunch. There are fast food restaurants within a few miles of the show site.

JUDGING SCHEDULE: Judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 AM each day. Rings will run alternately each day, starting with Ring 1. The tentative judging schedule is listed below; any changes will be specified in the final schedule that will be sent at the time of final confirmation.

Please check the appropriate box on the entry form so that the Trial Secretary knows whether your dog needs to be measured. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running; failure to do so could cause the loss of any Q's earned. If you are not sure whether your dog needs to be measured, please ask the Trial Secretary for assistance when entering.**

Christian Eckhoff is not a VMO (Volunteer Measuring Official), so dogs under age 2 that have an official temporary measurement, and dogs over age 2 that have at least one official measurement, will not need to be measured at these trials.

OBSTACLES: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups after entries close must be submitted in writing (e-mail is fine) so that the Trial Secretary receives them by **6:00 PM PDT on Monday March 2, 2020**. Include dog's call name, registration number, owner's name, class you are moving from, and class you are moving to. Send by postal mail, or by email to agilmals@gmail.com. ***If you do not receive a prompt acknowledgement of your move-up request, please contact the Trial Secretary to make sure that it was received.*** No phone move ups accepted. Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday move-ups will be accepted at the trial; they must be submitted in writing no later than 30 minutes after the trial is concluded each day.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS to Grant County Fairgrounds

From I-90 Eastbound: Take I-90 to Exit 176 onto W. Broadway Ave. Go NE on Broadway approx. 2.8 miles to the intersection of W. Broadway and N. Stratford/S. Alder (the street names are different on the left and right side of W. Broadway). Turn left (north) onto N. Stratford and proceed across the bridge to W. Valley Rd and turn left. After passing the fairgrounds on the right, turn right on Airway Drive and continue to the fairgrounds entrance.

From I-90 Westbound: Take I-90 to Exit 179 and exit to Highway 17 North. Follow 17 North around the top of the lake to Grape Dr NE (about 5 miles) and turn left onto Grape Dr NE. Grape Dr. NE is the first major intersection after the Highway 17/N. Stratford intersection. Follow Grape Dr NE south to W. Valley Rd and turn right. After passing the fairgrounds on the right, turn right on Airway Drive and continue to the fairgrounds entrance.

Entrance to Fairgrounds

Use the GOLD gate entrance (near the Fair office, on the West side of the Fairgrounds). The gate will open at 2:00 PM on Thursday, March 5, 2020. It will close at 10:00 PM each day. It will re-open at 6:00 AM each day.

ALL reserved overnight parking/camping is \$35.00 per night (\$90 for 3 night package deal) – please send in parking form included with this premium list. Electrical hookups are available; ***water hookups may or may not be available, depending on the temperature and on whether the Fairgrounds staff has turned the water on.***

A complete set of rules for all classes is available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site www.akc.org. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to enter their dog in the correct class. **The Trial Secretary cannot make any changes after the closing date of the trial, except for move-ups as noted, and for dogs ineligible for the class in which they are entered, in specific situations as provided in the AKC Agility Regulations.** Be sure to check your entry form carefully and make certain you have entered the correct class(es). **If you have questions about which class to enter, please contact the Trial Secretary before the closing date.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. **Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement attached, are not acceptable. ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE THE AGREEMENT and MUST BE SIGNED; otherwise they are considered to be invalid.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee, except for bitches in season as specified on page 2. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging times will be sent to the address given on the AKC entry form after the closing date. **If the exhibitor provides an e-mail address, it is assumed that the exhibitor can receive e-mail with attachments from the Trial Secretary, and confirmation will be sent by e-mail;** please make sure your spam blocker is set to accept messages from agilmals@gmail.com. If an e-mail address is not provided, or if postal mail is specifically requested, confirmation of entry will be sent by postal mail. If an exhibitor has not received a confirmation and schedule at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

The **Ephrata-Moses Lake Kennel Club and the Trial Secretary** assume **NO** responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and /or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and /or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering the Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of the sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Please clean up after your dogs on the show grounds and at your motel. We want to retain these facilities for future events.

ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under The AKC rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

NEW INFORMATION: Class Changes Effective January 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights [in different classes] within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend, thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. [EXAMPLE: if you are entering a dog in some Regular classes and some Preferred classes, submit one entry form for the Regular classes, and another entry form for the Preferred classes.]

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

DAY PARKING: NO CHARGE

Prepaid Parking Forms must be postmarked no later than February 19, 2020. Otherwise, parking is \$45.00 per night or \$100 for 3 nights, paid in CASH.

HANDICAP PARKING – Handicap parking is to provide suitable surface to the rings, not necessarily close to the rings. Handicap parking will be charged at the parking rates listed; space is VERY LIMITED. All handicap vehicles must have a handicap license plate. Please indicate on your parking form so we can reserve a space for you.

RULES AND REGULATIONS – Parking will be self serve. The area will be designated with signs; if you have any questions, check with someone in the kitchen area of the pavilion. If you have any special needs please indicate on your parking form so we can reserve a spot for you. Group parking is first come, first serve. The first person in your group may hold a few spots around them for those coming. These are large campgrounds with plenty of room for your groups. When parking, please be respectful of the roadway space and your neighbors.

If there are any issues, the parking committee reserves the right to park vehicles by size and need as to best benefit the operation of the show and inflict the least amount of damage to the grounds as possible. ***All overnight parking with or without hookups (including tents and autos) will be charged the same rate. Water hookups may or may not be available, depending on temperature conditions and whether the Fairgrounds personnel have turned on the water.***

AGREEMENT

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
